



Edgewater Residents Have Multiple Financial Resources Available to them Right Now

1. *City of Edgewater’s Residential Assistance Program*

Grants of \$300 are available for ANY Edgewater household that has lost income due to the COVID crisis

Requirements:

- i. Must live in Edgewater
- ii. Must provide evidence that you have lost 30% of your household income after March 17
- iii. Only one grant available per household

2. *Rent and Mortgage Assistance*

Available statewide, this is funding for emergency rent and mortgage payments for applicants that have been economically impacted by the COVID crisis

Requirements:

- i. Household income must have been below 80% AMI BEFORE the COVID crisis began

- ii. Must be able to provide evidence of financial hardship due to COVID

3. *Utility Bill-Pay Assistance*

Available statewide, this funding is for those who are struggling to pay their home energy costs

Requirements:

- i. Household income must be below 80% AMI (see below)

- ii. Energy bill must be past due, or you are running low on fuel
- iii. Must first apply for Colorado’s low income energy assistance program ([LEAP](#))
