Program Description

Edgewater Collective is committed to offering additional academic and holistic supports during the summer of 2021 to continue addressing the needs of students and families that the pandemic has magnified. We are focused on offering a six week Jefferson Success Academy to accelerate student learning for 3rd-5th grade students in the Jefferson Area schools (Edgewater Elementary, Lumberg Elementary and Molholm Elementary). Two teachers will be assigned to each grade with site coordinator to provide support and feedback. Teachers will team-teach fifteen students in their classroom.

Curriculum

We will be utilizing the i-Ready curriculum from Curriculum Associates to provide personalized support in math and reading for students. This curriculum monitors student progress and allows teachers to group students by their learning strengths and gaps.

Responsibilities

- Provide leadership for the daily activities of the program and guide the development of a caring learning community
- Support instructional program by coaching and encouraging teachers
- Daily contact with families and students to exchange information and resolve issues
- Ensure student safety and carry out discipline guided by the principles of restorative practices
- Use data to analyze student learning and manage progress toward learning goals
