Each grade will have a dual language class and an English instruction class.

Curriculum

We will be utilizing the i-Ready curriculum from Curriculum Associates to provide personalized support in math and reading for students. This curriculum monitors student progress and allows teachers to group students by their learning strengths and gaps.
