Program Description

Edgewater Collective is committed to offering additional academic and holistic supports during the summer of 2023 to continue addressing the needs of students and families that the pandemic has magnified. We are focused on offering a six week Jefferson Success Academy to accelerate student learning for incoming 4th-6th grade students in the Jefferson Area schools (Edgewater Elementary, Lumberg Elementary and Molholm Elementary). A lead teacher and a co-teacher will be assigned to a classroom of 12-15 students with an instructional coach to provide support and feedback. Each grade will have a dual language class and an English instruction class.

Enrichment

Students will have an enrichment class for 30 minutes Mondays through Thursdays. Enrichment teachers will lead two 30 minute enrichment blocks three days a week. 12-15 students will be in each enrichment class. Enrichment classes will be focused on art, STEM, music, physical education or an interest area of the enrichment teacher. All needed resources will be paid for by Edgewater Collective.
