A lead teacher and a co-teacher will be assigned to a classroom of 12-15 students with an instructional coach to provide support and feedback.

Curriculum

We will be utilizing the i-Ready curriculum from Curriculum Associates to provide personalized support in math for students. This curriculum monitors student progress and allows teachers to group students by their learning strengths and gaps.

- Create lesson plans based on the curriculum and modify accordingly
- Utilize various curriculum resources and technologies to enhance student learning
- Utilize learning materials that honor and reflect the diverse educational, cultural, and linguistic backgrounds of the students served

- Prepare and distribute parent communications
- Manage student behavior in the classroom creating appropriate behavior strategies.
